

## Opportunities for those returning to a Discover Retreat

Do you feel like you would like to recapture your original Discover experience? Any one can return to a retreat and participate in one of 3 ways, Prayer Team, Bible Study or Small Group Leader.

The Prayer team under girds every aspect of the retreat with prayer. They also pray for concerns of individuals who have come to the retreat.

The Serendipity Bible study group does a study on a different topic at each retreat. Participants also learn how to lead a Serendipity Bible study at home or in their church. There are plenty of opportunities for your Discover experience to continue on. Give it a try!

Group leaders are an integral part of the experience as they facilitate the small groups and lead the New Discoverers in their exploration experience.
