Outreach in simple language means telling believers about Discover God's Call and encouraging them to participate in the programs offered by Discover God's Call.

The Mississippi Chapter of Discover God's Call has developed a grassroots outreach plan that provides for an Outreach Coordinator in each District of the Mississippi Conference. (Participation in Discover God's Call is interdenominational.) Data reveals that most new Discoverers attend a Discover God's Call Retreat as a result of personal contact by a graduate Discoverer. Therefore, the Chapter Plan for Outreach is not intended to replace the personal contact method.

The Chapter/District Outreach Plan will get the message of Discover God's Call to large groups such as district meetings of pastors, leadership teams and local church leadership training. Also, to groups within the districts such as cluster meetings and individual church groups and other Christian groups.

Each district will have a Coordinator for Outreach who will build an outreach team. Discoverers in each district are encouraged to contact the District Coordinator and volunteer to be a member of the team. A list of the District Coordinators, with telephone numbers is on the web site.
