I lived in Atmore, Al and was a Realtor there for 10 years. We were transplants from Arkansas when we moved to Atmore. I have 4 children (all grown and married) and 10 3/4 Grandchildren. As a result of DGC I have two ministries that I carry with me wherever I go. I have a chapter of Threads Of Love which sews tiny garments and provides visual proof of God's love to parents who are grieving or praying for an infant born too soon. We are there to hug, counsel,

and listen to those members of the family who need our support. The other ministry is a Prayer Shawl ministry which has become a part of First Church here in Corinth and began as a knitting class. We have donated 16 shawls to date. I was transplanted to Corinth when Hurricane Ivan destroyed our home in Atmore and we decided it was time we moved closer to our daughter here in Corinth. God has been guiding my life for many years

now, and I can't wait until tomorrow, cause it gets better each day! Once again I thank each of you in the email loop who have supported me with your prayers for our grandson, JR who was born at 28 weeks gestation, but certainly not too soon in God's time.
